Sisters of St. Joseph of Orange: Chapel Renovation

This 2003 remodel of a 1950's era Chapel included a new cupola, meditation area, baptismal fountain, a new altar, and screened sanctuary. TDM's phased approach to remodel the Chapel was as follows:

Phase I: Provide seismic strengthening of the existing Chapel, which serves the adjacent convent and assisted living facility without destroying the existing character of the exterior of the building.

Phase II: Remodel the interior of the Chapel to reflect the new liturgical ideals of the congregants and allow for better wheelchair accessibility.

Phase III: Introduce more natural light and improve lighting to accentuate the interior architecture of the Chapel.
