This project houses a new physics, chemistry, and two biology rooms in a one story concrete masonry unit structure with a sloping metal roof. Each laboratory has its own teacher’s prep room and its own storage room. The air conditioning equipment and exhaust fans are hidden by a screen which is incorporated into the sloping roof of the building. The four classrooms are grouped into a “U” shape to serve as a terminus of a long north south walkway spine through the center of the existing campus and to serve as a “Science Quadrangle”. Work included substantial new site work and utilities and modernization of adjacent restroom facilities.
