Latona Avenue Elementary School **Multipurpose Building**

The plan for this \$3.863 Million project was to construct a 2,500 SF multi-purpose building for the Latona Elementary School. In order to site the building in a compatible location adjacent to the existing main building, some “bungalow” type modular classroom buildings had to be demolished, and a second classroom and office building had to be constructed in order to relocate the students and staff utilizing the bungalow classrooms. This required phasing of the project. A campus wide fire alarm upgrade and a new electrical service upgrade was also included in the scope.
